

Proposed .22 LR, Long Range Benchrest Shoots at Butler City Hunting and Fishing Club

RIFLES: Any .22 LR, Two Classes: Stock – Any standard manufactured .22, scoped or open target sights. Upgraded triggers are permitted. Custom – Any custom altered or constructed .22 LR, Any rifles with barrel tuners. * Final determination of classification will be at the discretion of the Match Director.

RESTS: Any front rest, adjustable, joystick, bi – pod or bags. *One-piece rests are prohibited.

Ammunition: Any standard or target .22LR ammunition is permitted.

Distances: 100 & 200 yds. 25 shots for score @ 100 yds. Unlimited shots at the Sighter Target during the 10-minute, warm-up prior to the 25 minute timed, shoot for score. 25 shots for score at 200 yds. Unlimited shots at the Sighter Target during the 10-minute warm-up session prior to the 25-minute, timed shoot for score.

Targets: Proposed targets to be standard IBS 50 yd. @ 100 Yds. Standard IBS 100 Yd. @ 200 Yds. targets may be changed in future matches if those mentioned above prove to be too difficult.

Scoring: There are a possible 250 points for both, 100 Yd. And 200 Yd relays. A total of 500 points are available from both relays. An “x” will be when the center dot in the 10 ring is touched. “x”s will be used as tie breakers. A perfect score will be 500 – 50X. Appointed target scorer’s judgements are final.

Safety: When anyone is down range the safety flag must be lowered. All rifles must have their actions opened and any magazines removed. Open actions must have appropriate “empty action” indicators installed and clearly visible. Rifles may be stored in the vertical gun racks behind the benches, with their actions open and magazines removed in lieu of using “empty action” indicators.

Costs: There will be a \$2.00 fee to cover the cost of the targets used. **No prizes** are to be awarded. This is a “fun shoot”.

Eligible Shooters: Shoot to be open to all shooters, members of BCHFC and the general public.

Relays: There are five available benches for each relay. Relay assignments will be on a first come first served basis.

Proposed Dates: Shoots proposed for the 1st & 3rd Wednesdays of the month. Practice rounds to start at 3:00 P.M. Scoring relays to begin at 4:00 P.M. Competition will end by posted shooting times.
